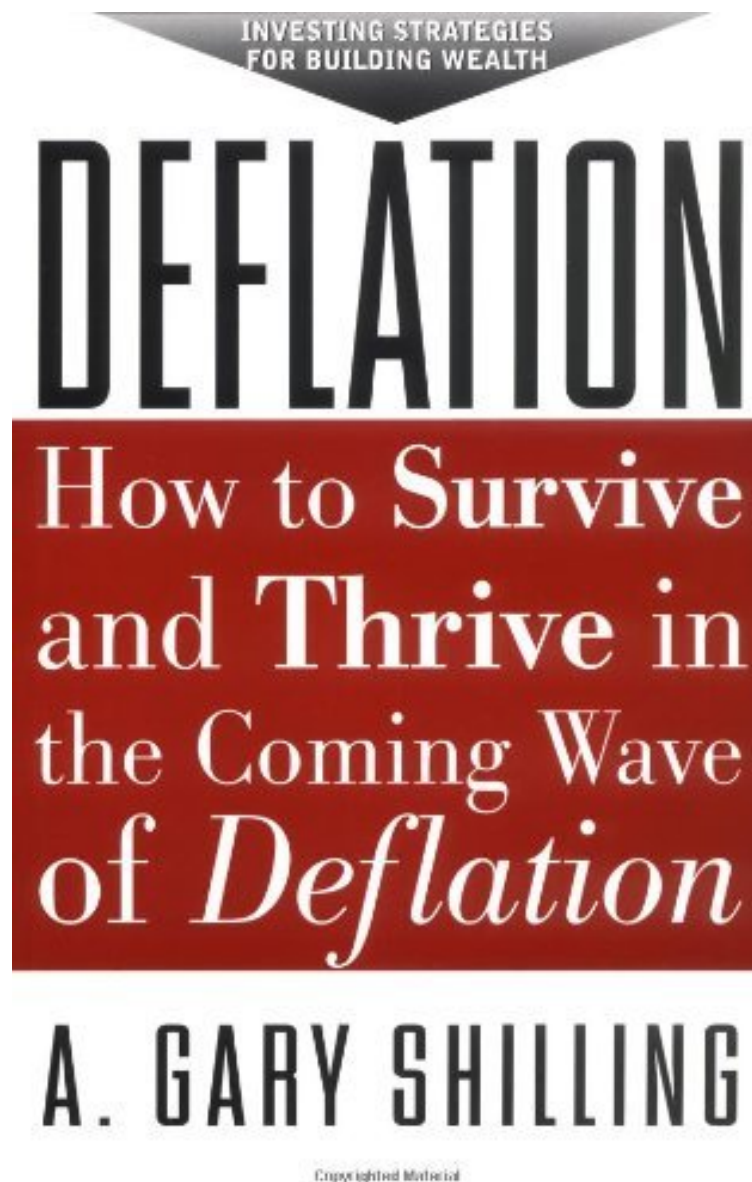

Schilling's first book about Deflation in the late 1990's when everyone else was focused on the tech boom and INflation. Needless to say it was a different read but it was very valuable to me as I was about to retire and I wanted the fullest possible perspective before making some key decisions. [I am a retired banker with an advanced degree in finance, but we all need help at retirement!]It was very valuable to me, challenging me to focus on the key issues for my particular situation.Of course this was all pre-9/11 and the war on terror and the 2008-09 financial meltdown. So I was very interested in an update, especially given the difficulties in Europe and Japan, and America's overspending and debt problem.Again, this was a good and valuable use of my time but the book is way too long, with more than a third of it devoted to describing "great calls" Gary has made in the past. This bugged me for two reasons:1. Most people who read this kind of stuff do so because of the author's track record; he's got a good one.2. Some of it seemed like "score settling".If this is your first Schilling book you may find these discussions to be useful because they establish his record as a analyst with an independent view, but if you already know that about him, it's tiresome.Having said that, wading through it all is still very worthwhile because the analysis is backed up with data, the trends identified are important, and he gives advice on action steps.Just be sure you don't bet everything on any one economist's views, even Gary Schilling!0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
