The theory is ok, real World examples are very useful, but for a student in the end it all gets to the exam and practising exercises. First not all exercises have answers, which makes it impossible to check the solutions. Second those that have, often have arithmetical mistakes in the solutions and inconsistency between the data used in questions and in solutions. If you ask for USD 100-150 for a book, you should be able to check the maths in the solutions. This is, in my opinion, unacceptable for a textbook for students.
